## **Chinese New Year of the Goat (Sheep)**



To turn the energies of this year to our benefit, to success and to happiness, it's important to watch a few rules, take some precautions and be ready for changes.

### **1. Protective measures for your home and office:**

- ❖ Prepare a sheer or blue colored **glass** (size not important) with **6 Pennies** (or copper coins) and **1 Nickel** (or silver colored coin), add one third of **kosher/coarse salt**, fill it up with **water** and put in the **West** of your home and office. You may hide it behind some objects, but don't close or touch it till February 2016, as it will absorb a lot of negative energy throughout the year.  
Throw away the old glass of 2014 which was in the NW.

**If your bedroom, your office or the direction of your bed is in the West, try to change it.**

- ❖ Hang a **string of Chinese coins** in the **South-east** this year (or metal plate, metal wind chime, Hamsa ...)  
against illness.
- ❖ Place a **plant in water or a Lucky Bamboo** with a piece of **red paper** (a red place mat underneath or red ribbon for example) in the **South** against law problems.

If your home has more than one floor, do all these corrections on each floor.

Please note:

- ❖ **Don't sit with your face to the South-west in 2015!**

**Check the direction of your desk in your office, and make the necessary changes.** Use a compass, if necessary.

**The best advice to avoid the negative energies is, to avoid the specific rooms or at least keep them as quiet as possible!**

- ❖ **Do not travel straight to the South-west direction.** This is especially important for those who have a problem in their profile and the ones born in the years of Goat, Dog and Ox.

### **2. If your home or office faces to South-west or West:**

- ❖ **Don't start any renovations** this year, which also applies to any South-west and West part in each room.
- ❖ Hang a **metal wind chime** at the entrance.

### **3. For all born in the years of Goat, Dog and Ox:**

It will be a year for you of challenges, activities, travelling and changes.

- ❖ **Travel a lot, but be careful. The direction South-west is not the best for you!**
- ❖ **Watch your health.**
- ❖ **Take the traditional Chinese protection charm for this year: the Horse.**

**Year of the Goat: 1943, 1955, 1967, 1979, 1991, 2003 and 2015**  
**Year of the Dog: 1934, 1946, 1958, 1970, 1982, 1994 and 2006**  
**Year of the Ox: 1937, 1949, 1961, 1973, 1985, 1997 and 2009**

Please note that the Chinese year begins only on 4th or 5th of February. Who is born thus in January, must take the year before. If you are not sure, you may ask me anytime.

### **4. Especially for all who are born in the year of the Pig, Rabbit and Horse:** **It will be a very positive and successful year.**

**Years of the Pig: 1935, 1947, 1959, 1971, 1983, 1995, 2007**  
**Years of the Rabbit: 1939, 1951, 1963, 1975, 1987, 1998, 2011**  
**Year of the Horse: 1942, 1954, 1966, 1978, 1990, 2002, 2014**

According to Chinese tradition it's possible to enhance the positive energies of the Goat by adding a **Goat statue to the South-west** part of the house, the direction of the Goat. Of course this is **not allowed** for the ones born in the years of Goat, Dog or Ox!!!

**There are great energies this year in the**  
**East, North-east, North and South-west.**  
**You can absorb them by using these parts of your home more often!**
